Dear Parents and Guardians

Coronavirus (COVID – 19). Further communication.

Important update regarding COVID -19 developments:

The President announced that all school will be closed from **Wednesday, 18 March 2020** and re-opens on **Tuesday 14 April 2020**. **School will close at 11:00 on Wednesday, 18 March 2020.**

End of term reports will be sent home on Wednesday with the learners, or can be **collected from the Admin office between 08:00 and 11:00 sharp. This arrangement will only be valid if your child/ren is sick on the day.** Please send an email to school if you will be collecting your child's report. **Only parents, who send this request, will be assisted.**

We normally do not have after school activities during the last week of term.

The closure of the school by the President is a **precautionary measure to minimise contact.**

We therefore urge you to **avoid public places** such as Cinemas, play areas, entertainment areas, etc.

Our Teaching staff will furnish you with planning as well as activities for the learners to complete at home while under your supervision. This will be sent home with the reports on Wednesday.

Please ensure that you are on Clasdojo and communicate with the Teacher in case there are further developments and should there be any changes.

1. Wash your hands thoroughly and frequently with soap and water. (20 seconds), or use an alcohol based hand sanitizer.
2. Avoid touching your face unnecessarily
3. Cough or sneeze into a disposable tissue, or into a crooked elbow if necessary.
4. Discard the tissue in a waste bin.
5. Avoid public areas to minimise risk.

6. Travel bans have been instituted against certain countries which have been labelled as high risk.
7. Please avoid contact with persons who have travelled to these countries.

Should your child not be well, please keep them at home and assessed by an appropriate medical specialist.
